## Letter of understanding about childcare provision for children of essential workers or vulnerable pupils at Fakenham Junior School

The following measures are to reduce the risk of transmission between children and staff at the childcare provision.

This is an **'emergency' provision** that should only be used if it is **'absolutely'** necessary therefore your child should only attend the provision when either both 'essential worker' parents in your household are working or in the case of a sole parent in your household that 'essential worker' is attending work. **It runs from 8:40am to 3:15pm Monday to Friday inclusive.**

If your child or anyone else in the household is displaying symptoms of CoVid-19 then the whole household should self-isolate for 14 days. Ensure you follow government guidelines.

If your child is not attending the provision you must phone and inform us.

If your child becomes ill or displays symptoms of CoVid-19 they will be placed in isolation and you will be contacted. You are expected to collect them as soon as possible and follow all public health guidelines.

This provision is not statutory and as such if your child puts themselves or others at risk in a way that is deemed unacceptable then the offer of the provision may be removed.

This is not 'school', whilst some activities might be educational, we are not expected to deliver the national curriculum or to 'teach' your child. We withhold the right to offer any activity that we deem suitable on a given day.

We will feed your child at lunchtime when they are at our provision; either with a hot dinner or cold packed lunch; they should not bring lunch from home. We reserve the right to cease to offer this at any point – we would inform you at least the day before if this is the case.

When your child attends they should:

- Come in clean clothes each day; this includes PE kit.
- Wash their hands just before leaving home and follow all hygiene routines initiated at the provision.
- Not bring anything in from home i.e pens, pencil cases, toys etc

**If the provision cannot be staffed safely due to staff illness or absence then we reserve the right to close the provision at short notice. We would inform you when the provision would re-open as soon as possible.**
