

EdenRed Free School meal vouchers update:

Since the Covid Pandemic, Norfolk County Council has funded monthly extra food vouchers for children in receipt of free school meals, for all schools. Due to a change in funding from central government this will be ending, with the vouchers in March 2026 being the last distributed. They will still be supporting the most vulnerable households around the 'cost of living' but details of any new offer have not yet been released. The Norfolk Big Holiday Fun Scheme will be continuing – this included a free lunch. We urge you to book places on the events when they are released.

I hope you are all able to enjoy the half term break and the weather is a little less glum and damp - at least the evenings are getting a bit lighter. Remember it is Pancake Day on Tuesday 17th February, making pancakes is a great activity to do with children – I particularly like eating them!!
